One day, while the children are dreaming of reviving the tree, they see a huge ship far out on the horizon, approaching the beach of Rikuzentakata.

The ship heading toward the shore has 19,139 people on board.

All of the people whose lives were taken away by the tsunami.

A firefighter who lost his life while trying to rescue others.

A loved one who lost her grip after being defeated by the pressures of the tides.

A fisherman, a driver, a mother and a child, a grandfather, a teacher who protected his students until the last moment, a town official who never let her hand off the microphone while she attempted to warn people to evacuate, a postman who was swept away while delivering letters.

A doctor, a chef, a high school student-wearing a uniform, an elderly woman who escaped to the roof before being swept away, a girl who was swallowed by the wave while carrying a satchel on her back, every one of them who was swept away by the tsunamis is on board the big ship.
